The Brazilian College of Agriculture and Veterinary Medicine (ESAMV), established in 1910, was the precursor to the Federal Rural University of Rio de Janeiro (UFRRJ).

With a history of teaching Agricultural, Exact and Biological Sciences, UFRRJ has diversified its activities in recent decades and now it offers courses in all areas of knowledge.

Campus

The Federal Rural University of Rio de Janeiro has four campuses across the state of Rio de Janeiro – Seropédica, Nova Iguaçu, Três Rios, and Campos dos Goytacazes.

Courses

Currently, the University offers **61 undergraduate programs** – three of which are distance learning –, and **40 graduate programs**.

On the Seropédica campus, the Institution also offers free technical high school education at **CTUR (Technical College of UFRRJ)**.

Teaching, Research and Extension

Undergraduate Courses

UFRRJ offers 58 in-person Undergraduate Courses - students attend classes on Seropédica, Nova Iguaçu and Três Rios campuses. It also offers 3 distance learning Undergraduate Courses.

Research and Graduate Courses

Currently, there are 40 Graduate Programs offering professional master's degree, *stricto sensu* master's degree, and doctorates, as well as *lato sensu* Graduate Programs.

Extension

UFRRJ is involved in several extension actions and projects, with emphasis on the free Pré-Enem UFRRJ course - a preparatory for the entrance exam; the Semana Rural event - the largest one of the region; and initiatives in favor of culture, sports, and leisure.
